As we look back on 2023 and read testimonies from our girls, we have found a common theme in their stories since coming to Angel's House: **growth and perseverance**. The first line of our mission statement is to provide a safe and secure environment for teens. For 19 years, we have worked to build a home characterized by love, support, and stability. Our goal is for our teens to feel safe in the present, work to heal from their past and begin to plan for their future.

Below are some quotes from our current angels which mean the world to us as they clearly show that staying true to our mission is helping change the trajectory of our girls' lives:

*"Since being at Angel's House I have been able to focus on my future and let go of my past to live my life to the fullest. They also taught me responsibility and patience. They once told me that **"we can't forget our trauma"** but we can learn how to live beyond it. After all that I went through, I have learned that I can still have a life that I love, and Angel's House has helped me see this. They have taught us courage and purpose. I am so thankful for Angel's House."* – 13 year-old

*"While being at Angel's House, they have **helped me open up to the people around me, grow in my faith, control my emotions, and learn how to be a better person overall.** I have learned what it is like to have consistency and discipline while also being shown that they care."* – 14-year old

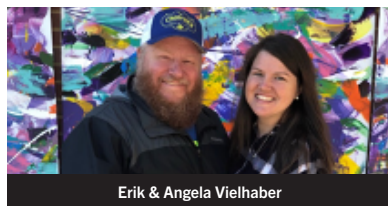

Angel's House Staff

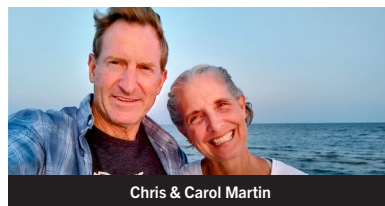

*"Over the past seven years, Angel's House helped me become an amazing student with amazing grades when I was not doing well in school. Not only that, but they helped me grow in my faith in God. Most importantly, **they helped me realize that I could choose my family.** I get to choose Angel's House as my family, and I am eternally grateful for them."* — 19-year old

In addition, one of our angels **wrote a speech for her public speaking class** that embodies what we hope every single one of our angels feel from living at Angel's House. We hope they all grow and overcome obstacles life throws their way knowing we are here for them to provide security and shelter.

*"Growing up, I lived with my grandparents. Some might think, "oh wow, how fun." Sadly, it was the opposite. I was always told I would never amount to anything and that I would grow up to be just like my lowlife parents. I was told that I was stupid and dumb. Sadly, I believed it for a long time. I genuinely thought I was nothing. I stopped trying in life, I stopped trying to believe there was hope for me until I was rescued and saved by the grace of God. That is when things changed for me. **I was placed in a home called Angel's House, and they helped me overcome the thoughts I once believed.** It was hard. But I started to see the brighter side of things. I accomplished so many things and started to believe I was worth something and I am. I am an overcomer; I overcame the horrid thoughts that once haunted me and left me paralyzed with fear. As I am older and I look at how far I have come, I am thankful. I appreciate how far I have come and believe that I can overcome any obstacle in my life. **I am now a junior in college and I have done everything I was told I couldn't.** Even further, I will graduate with a degree in Criminal Justice and will be an advocate for those who have a story like mine and show them how they can overcome their situations."* — Angilina, 22-year old

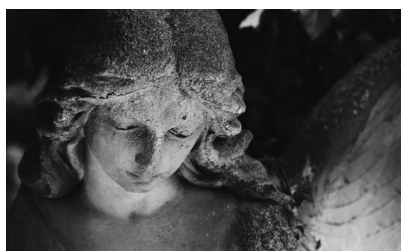

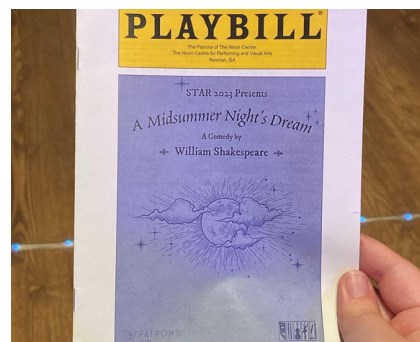
